The advocacy team has invested a large amount of time meeting with legislators and sharing with them information on the many benefits of the chemistry solutions we provide. While CCNJ's advocacy to stop these bans is ongoing, there are more than 17 chemistry ban bills CCNJ is hoping to stop this Session.

We are active and vocal on regulatory concerns. This past year we tackled issues ranging from site remediation reform to changes to the Toxic Catastrophe Prevention Act (TCPA) to perfluoroalkyls regulations. In 2019, CCNJ submitted several comments on behalf of the membership to ensure industry's concerns were heard on important regulatory updates.

CCNJ's strategy continues to evolve in the new political landscape. We continue to share how the industry is part of the solution, and leverage coalitions to help support our chemistry solutions.
